BACKGROUND

Dutch billiards or “Sjoelback” started to become known outside the Netherlands in the 19th century.

MATERIALS

- A smooth surface approximately 2 meters long with four bridges numbered from 1 to 4
- 10 to 30 disks

Object of the game

To win the most points in three turns.

PROGRESS OF THE GAMES

Each player has 3 attempts to slide as many disks under bridges as possible. In the third attempt each player takes any disks that did not slide under the bridges and tries to throw them over the bridges. Players typically play multiple rounds. Players add points gained in all rounds to form cumulative scores. The first player to reach a cumulative score of 30-50 points wins.
